1. Shestudied really hard. She passed all her exams with excellent grades.

A can't have B might have

C must have

2. You shouted at him. He'll never forgive you.

A shouldn't have B must have

C can't have

3. He arrived by now. It's a 2-hour journey. It is too early for that

A shouldn't have B might not have

C can't have

4. The concert was fantastic. You really come.

A could have B should have

C must have

5. The boss is in a terrible mood. The meeting been good.

A might not have B shouldn't have

C can't have

6. Sarah been so happy when she found out she was being promoted.

A must have B should have

C can't have

7. I had to wait 45 minutes for a bus yesterday. There been an accident or maybe a strike.

A shouldn't have B can't have

C might have

8. He bought a new car. He doesn't have any money.

A might have B can't have

C must have

9. Andrew did no revision for the exam but he's passed. I think he cheated.

A must have B should have

C might have

10. I left my bicycle in front of the library and it's disappeared. Someone stolen it.

A must have B could have

C should have

11. Clara was very upset with you yesterday. You apologised for saying she was lazy.

A must have B can't have

C should have

12. John has forgotten about the meeting. We reminded him about it yesterday.

A must have B should have

13. I'm sorry but Samantha isn't here. She already left the office.

A can't have B must have

14. You tried to fix the roof yourself. You might have fallen off and been badly injured.

A must have B might not have
